## PARKING AREA CHANGES

November 26, 2007- January 2009

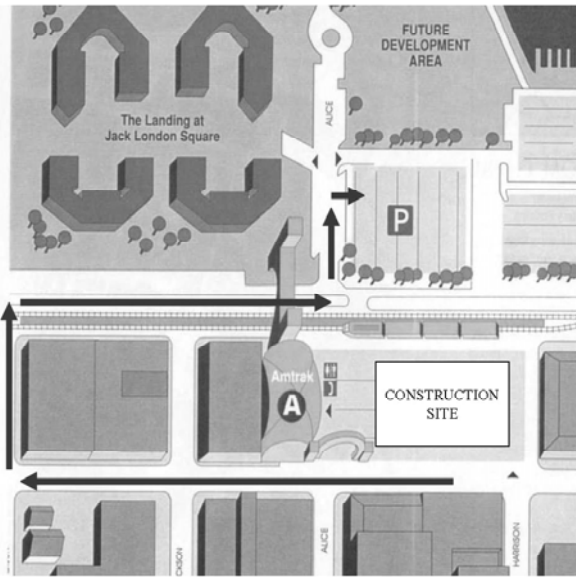
As of Monday, November 26, 2007 Amtrak passengers will be required to park in a new parking area located at 200 Embarcadero West due to construction taking place on the site of the existing parking lot.

### Project Summary

The Port of Oakland will begin construction of a new parking garage at the Oakland Jack London train station on **Monday, November 26, 2007**. The new 7-story garage will be built on the site of the current parking lot and plans include retail space on the ground floor in addition to 1,100 parking stalls. Construction is expected to last approximately one year.

### Parking

During the construction period, parking for Amtrak passengers will be relocated. No parking will be allowed in the current lot.



Amtrak parking will be temporarily moved to Jack London's Waterfront Parking lot at the corner of Embarcadero and Alice, approximately one block from the station across the pedestrian overpass. The address is 200 Embarcadero West. Amtrak is not responsible for the security of passenger's vehicles parked in this lot. Please refer to the map at left.

Passengers can reach this parking area by utilizing the pedestrian overpass at the Jack London station. Plan accordingly to allow enough time to get from the new parking area to the station platform, as trains will not wait for pedestrians on the overpass.

Passengers will be required to pay for parking in this lot. Cash only. Rates are:

0-2 hours	= \$2
2-12 hours	= \$5
12-24 hours	= \$9

### Amtrak Motorcoaches

Passengers planning to transfer to/from Amtrak Thruway Motorcoach buses can board those buses on 2<sup>nd</sup> street, directly across the street from the station. The Amtrak Thruway Motorcoach bus signs will be relocated to the new boarding/off-boarding site, along with additional signage, to direct passengers to the correct location.

### Connecting Transit

Passengers planning to transfer to local AC Transit buses can board those buses on Alice Street (at the intersection of Alice and 2<sup>nd</sup> street), across the street from the station.
